



Scholarship

The Twins, Triplets, and More Association of Calgary (TTMAC) scholarship was created to encourage families to pursue a higher level of education. Maximum of \$1,500 (2018/2019 school year) to be awarded to up to eight (8) applicants depending on number of qualifying applicants annually. The scholarships will be chosen by a selection committee comprising of Executive Board Members. Current TTMAC Board Members and immediate family members of the TTMAC Board of Directors are not eligible to apply. The scholarship program is subject to annual approval by the TTMAC Board of Directors during the budget planning and based on availability of funds.

Criteria for Eligibility:

- Calgary and surrounding area residents who have successfully completed first year studies (within the last two years) and are registered in a subsequent year (second, third or fourth year of postsecondary studies, masters program or continuing education).
- Considerations may include but are not limited to the following: financial need, extracurricular activities, educational marks, achievements and community involvement.
- Proof of registration is required before payment is issued (photocopy of cancelled cheque, visa or debit receipt is acceptable).
- Cheque payments will be made payable directly to the recipient once the recipient meets the eligibility requirements of the scholarship committee.

Deadline

Deadline for submitting complete application package is **December 31** each calendar year.

Payments will be issued prior to February 28 to addressee on applications. Incomplete or late application forms will not be considered.

Apply

Along with other requirements listed in the application package, all applications must include a paragraph explaining why you deserve this scholarship along with a 500 word essay on one of the following topics. This essay may be shared publicly with members of TTMAC:

- The Needs, Challenges and Benefits of Multiples (Twins, Triplets, Quads or Higher)
- Knowing someone who is a multiple and the impact it has had on their lives
- What being a multiple means to me
- How having siblings who are multiples have impacted my life
- Multiples throughout history
- What I want to be when I grow up
- My Life as a Parent of Multiples
- Pre-approved topic of your choice
